OUTALLS INTO ROCK CREEK. THE SSO EVENT ENDED PRIOR TO ARRIVAL OF THE

JET CREW. THE JET CREW REMOVED HEAVY GREASE AND WIPES FROM THE

ON-PROPERTY MANHOLE, TO END THE EVENT. NO FURTHER ACTION TAKEN

BECAUSE THIS WAS AN ON-SITE MANHOLE.

DETERMINED THAT THE OVERFLOW OCCURRED FROM A WSSC ASSET. THIS

TEAM. THE INFORMATION HAS BEEN UPDATED IN WSSC'S MAINTENANCE
