UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 026M OVERFLOWING AT 0.5 GPM INTO A NEARBY STORM DRAIN THAT OUTFALLS INTO PARKWAY BASIN. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE 025M TO 026M, A TOTAL OF 155', AND RELIEVED THE DEBRIS AT 146', TO END THE EVENT.
