CAUSE: STREAM EROSION EST OVERFLOW VOLUME: 698 GAL UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND THAT THE BYPASS PUMPING PIPE HAD BROKEN DUE TO RISING CREEK LEVELS FROM A FLASH FLOOD, RESULTING IN AN OVERFLOW OF APPROXIMATELY 3 GPM INTO BUCK BRANCH CREEK. A WSSC CONTRACTOR RECONNECTED THE BYPASS HOSES AND SECURED THEM TO THE BRIDGE, TO END THE EVENT.

BRIDGE WAS INSTALLED OVER THE BYPASS HOSE TO RESTORE FLOW AND PREVENT
RECURRENCE.
