CAUSE: DAMAGED BY OTHERS EST OVERFLOW VOLUME: 268 GAL UPON ARRIVAL, THE CREW FOUND MANHOLE 019M OVERFLOWING APPROXIMATELY 2 GPM, INTO A NEARBY STORM DRAIN IN THE OXON RUN BASIN. THE CREW JETTED FROM MANHOLE 018U TO 019M AND RELIEVED A BLOCKAGE CONSISTING OF HEAVY ASPHALT DEPOSITS WITHIN MANHOLE 019M, TO END THE EVENT. MULTIPLE RESIDENTS REPORTED THAT A CONTRACTOR HAD BEEN MILLING THE ROAD NEARBY, AND ASPHALT MATERIAL ENTERED THE MANHOLE.
